The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

By this order, Civil Writ Petition No.13652, 13653 and 5186 of 2017 shall stand disposed of.

These three writ petitions have been filed, challenging the show cause notice as also the order by which the petitioner (in each of the writ petitions) was placed under suspension. In the present case, the petitioner(s) were recruited as Assistant Lineman by the respondent-Corporation in the year 2012. Subsequently, the respondent-Corporation was informed that the certificates submitted by the petitioners in support of their technical qualification are either fake or from an unrecognized institution.

Respondents have stated that in each case some sort of the inquiry has been held to verify the validity of the certificates submitted by the petitioners which were found to be fake or from an unrecognized Institution.

Admittedly, no final order has been passed against the petitioners. The suspension, as is well known, is not an order of punishment.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered inappropriate to entertain these writ petitions without granting opportunity to the respondent-Corporation to pass final orders.

With these observations, all the writ petitions are disposed of with liberty to the respondents to pass final orders. The petitioners are also granted liberty to make a representation and draw attention of the respondent-Corporation to the alleged violation of the regulations as are sought to be projected in these writ petitions.
