The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 71 dated 17.07.2021 registered
under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station
Lakho Ke Behram, district Ferozepur.

On 16.09.2021, this Court had passed the following order : -

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia
contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in
this case; he has no criminal antecedents; even if the case
of the prosecution is taken as the gospel truth though
vehemently denied, there is no medical evidence to reveal
that the injury attributed to the petitioner is a grievous
injury and that the petitioner is ready and willing to join
the investigation as and when called by the investigating
agency.*

Adjourned to 06.12.2021.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-35737-2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.71, dated 17.07.2021, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Lakho Ke Behram, District Ferozepur, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer."

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 16.09.2021 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
