The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.184 dated 25.07.2020 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional Act, 2014 at Police Station Adampur District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of orders dated 26.10.2020 and 08.01.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has handed over demand drafts of Rs.4 lakhs to the counsel for the complainant on 10.01.2021.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Pal Singh submitted that the aforesaid amount has been handed over to learned counsel for the complainant. Learned State counsel further submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 06.03.2021 to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. Petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 08.01.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
