As agreed, as per statements of counsel for the appellants, counsel and representative of respondent No.3 - United India Insurance Company Limited (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lac and Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the MACT, Chandigarh, is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No. 1.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the respondent No.3 - United India Insurance Company Limited to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.4,50,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to counsel/representative of respondent No.3 - United India Insurance Company Limited. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file
be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
