Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with the prayer that the investigation of FIR No.93 dated 22.07.2021 registered for offence under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar be handed over to some independent agency or to some higher officials outside the District.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely framed in the FIR due to enmity with his neighbour-respondent No.5, who has acted in connivance with the police officials and involved the petitioner in the FIR. He submits that immediately on his arrest, his mother submitted representation, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District SBS Nagar and sent another representation to Punjab State Women Commission, Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively, which have not been attended to. Counsel further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar, District SBS Nagar-respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 23.07.2021, Annexure P-2.

Request made by counsel has been considered.

Without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representations, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar, District SBS Nagar, respondent No.2. to examine the representation dated 23.07.2021, Annexure P-2, and take suitable action thereon as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of the order alongwith the representation, Annexure P-2, be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar, District SBS Nagar - respondent No.2, so as to enable him to do the needful within a period of four weeks' from the date of receipt of the copy of the order.
