The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 14.09.2021, the following order was passed:-

*“This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition bearing filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/151/2021, titled as “Ankur Sharma Vs. Navjot Sharma”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Camp at Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.*

*The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 07.07.2014 and they have been blessed with a female child. She claims that presently, she is residing with her parents at Barnala and the distance between Fatehgarh and Barnala is more than 110 Kms. The petitioner further claims that she cannot properly defend the petition at Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.*

*The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the respondent (husband) has already filed a petition under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, at Barnala. He places reliance on the following litigations pending in District Courts, Barnala.*

*(i) Under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.*

*(ii) Under Section 125 Cr.P.C.*

*The learned counsel contends that it will be very difficult for the petitioner to travel on each date of hearing.*

*Notice of motion for 14.10.2021.  
The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the  
respondent through his counsel, at Civil Courts, Camp at  
Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.  
Dasti also.”*

The facts noticed in the order dated 14.09.2021, remain uncontroverted.

Hence, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing No.HMA/151/2021, titled as “Ankur Sharma Vs. Navjot Sharma”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Camp at Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 08.11.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
