ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner herein, inter alia, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 01.07.2021, claiming that his claim for grant of Grade 'A' Sports Gradation Certificate has been denied.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the case file.

3. From a perusal of the impugned speaking order (Annexure P-10), it is clearly borne out that the claim of the petitioner to seek the gradation certificate has not yet been negated. The same is still pending consideration, to be decided in accordance with the established procedure. For ready reference, relevant of the impugned order is reproduced herein below:-

“Further, keeping in view the order dated 01.04.2021 passed by the Hon’ble High Court in Civil Writ Petition No. 7451 of 2021, the competent authority i.e. Director Sports & Youth Affairs, Haryana and his officers have been directed to look at the issue of Sports Gradation Certificate. In order to do the same, the Sports Certificates submitted by the petitioner need to be verified from the concerned organizing authority i.e. International Olympic Committee (IOC)/ National Rifle

Association of India (NRAI) on the basis of which the petitioner is claiming issuance of the Sports Gradation Certificate. As and when the verification of the said Sports Certificates of petitioner will be received from the concerned organizing authorities/ IOC/ NRAI, the claim for issuance of Sports Gradation Certificate of the petitioner will be considered according to the policy/ instruction dated the 25th May, 2018 by the Director, Sports & Youth Affairs, Haryana and District Sports Officer, Yamunanagar.” (Emphasis supplied).

4. In the aforesaid premise, the writ petition as highly pre mature at this stage. Dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to follow up his case with the competent authority including Olympic Association as well as Rifle Association since they are the ones not responding to the queries made by the Director, Department of Sports and Youth Affairs.
