This is an application for impleading the complainant i.e. Poonam Kumari as a party respondent in the petition.

For the reasons recorded in the application, the same is allowed and Poonam Kumari is impleaded as respondent No.2 in the petition.

CRM-M-37518-2021

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.105 dated 11.07.2021, registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Kalka, District Panchkula, Haryana.

Vide order dated 10.09.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. Mr. Gurmeet Singh, AAG, Haryana for the State, at the outset, on instructions, informs the Court that in pursuance to the same, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 10.09.2021, is made absolute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought it to the notice of the Court that an amount of Rs.25,000/- awarded as litigation expenses to the complainant could not be paid to her because the petitioner is not having details of account number etc. of the complainant.

In view of the same, petitioner is directed to deposit an amount of Rs.25,000/- before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today for onward disbursal of the same to the complainant on proper identification.

Learned counsel for the complainant undertakes to convey this order to the complainant.

Petition stands allowed.
