The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.204 dated 01.08.2021, registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC (Section 325 and 326 IPC added later vide DDR No.17 dated 23.08.2021) at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Rural).

The operative part of the order dated 09.09.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a lady aged about 42 years and though the allegations against her are of causing the grievous injury invoking Section 326 of the IPC, however, considering the fact that the petitioner and the victim are resident of the same area and they are ready to settle the dispute, she volunteers to pay a sum of Rs.15,000/- towards the medical expenses borne by the victim.

Notice of motion.... ”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 09.09.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation and also deposited the amount of Rs.15,000/-.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sikander Lal, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.09.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
