[1] This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 202, dated 18th November, 2020, under Sections 324, 307, 148, 149 IPC and 201 IPC was added later on, registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar.

[2] As per the allegations, the incident took place on 17th November, 2020 in which Gurjot Singh Bhullar @ Guri Bhullar (petitioner) attributed injury with a sharp edged weapon on the head of Gurishaan Singh (respondent No.2/complainant).

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a 19 years college going student. He has no criminal antecedents. It was only during scuffle that the complainant fell down and received head injuries. He further submits that the matter has been compromised.

[4] Mr. Jatin Khullar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant and admits the factum of compromise.

[5] Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of bail. She submits that it is a case under Section 307 IPC, complainant got 16/18 stitches on his head. She submits that after doing the scan, doctor opined that the condition is not serious.

[6] The issue as to whether the case fall within the ambit of Section 307 IPC is debatable. The petitioner is in custody since 30th April, 2021. The investigation is complete. The petitioner is granted bail on furnishing surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

[7] The petition is allowed.

[8] It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
