 This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

 Petitioner is an Ex-serviceman and had applied for a flat pursuant to an advertisement issued by the Haryana Housing Board. He was declared successful in a draw of lots that was held on 29.12.2014. The registration amount as demanded by the Housing Board had also been deposited.

 For reasons not attributable to the petitioner the allotment of the Flat at Sampla did not fructify and accordingly consent was sought from the petitioner for allotment of the flat at Jhajjar instead of Sampla. In the communication seeking consent it was also made clear that in case the applicants are not interested in the Flat at Jhajjar they may opt for refund.

 The petitioner concededly opted for the refund.

Instant writ petition was filed raising a short grievance that inspite of substantial period of time having elapsed, the refund amount has not been made over.

Notice of motion was issued in the writ petition on 10.09.2021.

Mr.Aman Bahri, learned Addl.AG, Haryana informs the Court that a cheque drawn in the name of the petitioner for an amount of Rs. 5,15,274/- inclusive of the interest component already stands dispatched to the petitioner.

In the light of such development counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing would remain for adjudication.

Writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
