The petitioner was working as a Clerk when a number of FIRs were registered against him. He was acquitted in all of them except in one. Thus, his services were terminated in exercise of powers under Article 311 (2) of the Constitution of India. The appeal against the order of conviction was allowed and consequently, the petitioner was reinstated. However, arrears of salary have not been paid to him, till date. Legal notice dated 4.2.2020 (Annexure P-8) has also been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sanjay Mittal, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to seek a written statement.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 4.2.2020 (Annexure P-8), in accordance with law and after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
