By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.191, dated 05.09.2020, having been registered at Police Station Nangal, District Ropar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 21(1), 4(1) of the Mines and Minerals Act, 1957.

Learned State counsel submits, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently at least his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, since the investigating agency itself did not require the custodial interrogation of the petitioner, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
