The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the LTC payment of the petitioner as per the bill dated 11.08.2018 (Annexure P-5) alongwith interest @ 18% on account of delayed payment, for which, representation dated 18.06.2020 (Annexure P-9) has also been submitted before the

respondent authorities.

At the asking of the Court Mr. Ayush Sarna, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representation dated 18.06.2020 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
