The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this application, the petitioner prays for review of order dated 02.09.2021, which is extracted as under:-

*“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.*

*Through this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner assails the correctness of the order passed by the authorities removing him from the elected office of Councillor, Municipal Committee, Mahendergarh.*

*The appeal filed by the petitioner has also been dismissed. At the time of hearing, learned counsel representing the respondents has informed the Court that the petitioner has been removed from the office. If that be so, the present petition is rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.*

*All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.”*

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that he has never been removed from the elected office.

On notice, Sh. Narinder Singh Behgal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, has informed the Court that the petitioner was

disqualified from being a member of municipality for a period of three years from the date of order dated 10.02.2021. He further submits that the term of the petitioner has already come to an end and therefore, the petitioner cannot be reinstated.

Through this writ, the petitioner has assailed the correctness of orders passed by the authorities placing him under suspension. As, the term of the petitioner is over, the writ petition has correctly been dismissed as infructuous, accordingly.
