The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the rights, interest and title of the petitioner, who is a senior citizen and to take up measures against the respondents No.4 to 6 by way of issuing an injunction or any other appropriate order, along with certain other prayers.

The perusal of the petition shows that the petitioner is having statutory mechanism to get his grievance redressed under a different provision of law. Therefore, this court does not deem it appropriate to interfere in the matter.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
