HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner-Company is not being allowed to execute the work of labour and cartage as well as of transfer of the foodgrains for which the petitioner-Company has been awarded a valid tender. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the Labour Union is not allowing its workers to execute the work and the workers are being threatened, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that appropriate direction be issued to respondent No.2 to ensure that no interference is created by the private respondents in execution of the work, which has been validly allotted to the petitioner and is to be executed urgently.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already

served a legal notice dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) upon the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the legal notice dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by it in the legal notice dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-4), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
