**AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):**

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 42, dated 18.02.2019, under Sections 323, 325, 341, 379-B and 302 IPC, registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of false implication, in fact he had no role whatsoever to play in the alleged occurrence. He further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 20.02.2019 and there is no likelihood of the trial concluding in the near future as there are 29 prosecution witnesses.

Learned counsel for the State submits that out of twenty nine prosecution witnesses, twenty five witnesses have been examined and the next date fixed is 9.11.2021. She on instructions submits that an earnest effort would be made to conclude the prosecution evidence by 30.11.2021.

In view of the allegations made in the FIR, no case is made out for grant of regular bail at this stage.

The petition is disposed of.

There is no doubt that in case such a request is made before the trial court, the same would be dealt with in accordance with law.
