MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioners in service prior to cut off date so as to exclude them from purview of the amendment to the Punjab Civil Services Rules as well as the New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme. Further prayer is to allot the General Provident Fund (GPF) account numbers to the petitioners to make them eligible for the regular pension along with other retiral benefits. .

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioners, on instructions, submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 13.09.2020 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to

competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-10) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
