The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case bearing No.COMI/4580/2016 dated 24.10.2016/20.04.2017 titled as 'Jagroop Kaur Vs. Rajbir Singh and another' pending in the Court of learned JMJC, Amritsar under Sections 323, 325, 341, 506, 406, 498-A and 120-B IPC.

As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court, the parties failed to arrive at an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners happens to be the husband and mother-in-law of respondent No.2-complainant and the present complaint has been lodged on account of a matrimonial dispute between the parties. He further

submits that in compliance of order dated 12.07.2019, passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have appeared before the trial Court and was released on bail by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the submissions made by the counsel opposite.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 12.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
