By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.423, dated 18.09.2020, having been registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 406/420/506 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that other than the merits of the case, the petitioner has been in custody for more than 4 months with the *challan* already having been submitted and consequently, obviously his custodial interrogation is not required in any case.

Upon query to learned State counsel, he submits that out of 18 prosecution witnesses 5 have been examined so far.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be

admitted to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
