At the outset, learned counsel contends that Hon'ble the Division Bench vide order dated 05.10.2020, in LPA No.1843/2019, directed the contempt court to adjourn the proceedings to a date beyond 26.10.2020 and preferably await orders in the LPA, before proceeding further. Learned counsel contends that the aforesaid LPA is still pending adjudication, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition at this stage with liberty to file a fresh petition on the same cause of action, in the eventuality of modification of order of Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.1843 of 2019 or decision of LPA in favour of the petitioners whichever is earlier.

2. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
