Grievance of the petitioner is that pursuant to advertisement dated 26.02.2021 (Annexure P-1), he had submitted an on-line application for the slated examination of HCS (Executive Branch) and other Allied Services, to be conducted by Haryana Public Service Commission (here-in-after referred to as the 'HPSC') on 12.09.2021. Despite his having submitted the application form, complete in all respects, along with fee, his repeated attempts to download the admit card have been futile. Given that the examination is slated after two days from today i.e. 12.09.2021 and his fear is that he may not be permitted to take the examination for lack of admit card.

2. Learned counsel for HPSC, on advance service, joins proceedings and submits that he has already sought instructions from the competent person in the HPSC. As per his information, the petitioner had

applied twice by submitting two different applications. He submits that the petitioner can download his admit card by accessing his online application No.2165118 qua which the admit card has already been issued and even uploaded on the website. Roll No.125328 has been issued to the petitioner and therefore, his apprehension that he shall not be permitted to take the examination, is completely unfounded, provided he downloads the admit card from the website as per the prescribed procedure.

3. In the premise, in case, the petitioner reports at the Examination Centre along with admit card issued to him as aforesaid, he shall be allowed to take the examination.

4. No further grounds for interference are made out.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
