The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing as prayed by the learned counsels.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

On 10.09.2021, the following order was passed:-

“This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA/165/2021, titled as “Hardeep Singh vs. Sangita”, pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Family Court, Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 12.11.2019 and they have been blessed with a male child. She claims that presently, she is residing with her aged parents at Ludhiana and the distance between Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib and Ludhiana is more than 65 Kms. The petitioner further claims that she cannot properly defend the petition at Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner places reliance on the following litigations pending in District Courts, Ludhiana:-

- (i) Complaint under the Domestic Violence Act, 2005.*
- (ii) FIR bearing UID No.2079522, dated 07.07.2021, registered before the Incharge, Crime Against Women-I, Women Cell Ludhiana City.*

The learned counsel contends that it will be very difficult for the petitioner to travel on each date of

hearing.

Notice of motion for 11.10.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. Ram Gopal Sharda, at Civil Courts, Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The facts noticed in the aforesaid order dated 10.09.2021, remain uncontroverted. Hence, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA/165/2021, titled as “Hardeep Singh vs. Sangita”, pending in the Court of Additional District Judge, Family Court, Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 03.11.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
