Main case

By way of filing the instant petition, the petitioners were seeking a mandamus directing the official respondents to pass appropriate orders as regards sanctioning of the mutation of land measuring 24 kanals 8 marlas which was allotted to Sh.Ram Parshad i.e. predecessor-in-interest of the petitioners, situated within the revenue estate of village Meham, Hadbast No. 120, Tehsil Meham, District Rohtak comprising in Khewat No. 1982/1,

Khatauni No. 2321/2, Rectangle and Killa No.455//6, 7/1, 14, 15 as per Jamabandi for the year 2009-2010.

At the very outset Mr.Sharan Sethi, learned Addl. AG, Haryana, upon instructions from Major Gayatri Ahlawat, Sub Divisional Officer (Civil), Meham makes a statement that the mutation in question already stands sanctioned on 20.08.2019 vide No. 17307.

In the light of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the State nothing survives for adjudication in the instant writ petition and the same is disposed of as infructuous.
