It has been *inter alia* urged by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the investigating agency after the registration of the aforementioned FIR, has intentionally been going soft on the accused/private respondents despite ample evidence on record to show their active involvement in the alleged crime. It has further been submitted that even representation dated 11.12.2020 (Annexure P-11) was made to the official respondents in the said regard but in vain.

A prayer has therefore been made to issue directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to transfer the case to some other agency for investigation in FIR No.714 dated 20.11.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 354, 427, 452, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Ballabhgarh City District Faridabad.

I have heard learned counsel as well as perused the material on record.

It is not disputed that on the complaint of the petitioner, an FIR already stands registered against the accused. It needs to be noticed that the

investigation of a case falls within the exclusive domain of the investigating agency and this Court cannot step into the shoes of the investigating agency. In case the petitioner is aggrieved of the manner in which the investigating agency has proceeded subsequent to the registration of the FIR in question, he is at liberty to avail of the alternate remedy which may be available to him under the provisions of law.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
