This is a revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the trial Court to decide the application dated 02.06.2021 (Annexure P-2) for interim directions to respondent No.1/defendant No.2 to immediately restore the electricity connection bearing account No.Z74GT743439Y installed in the premises/House No.4-B, Skynet Enclave, Lohgarh, Zirakpur, Distt. SAS Nagar, Mohali, which has been disconnected by respondent No.1, on the behest of landlord/performa respondent No.2.

The grievance of the petitioner is against disconnection of electricity connection to the premises; where the petitioner is residing as a tenant, for the reason that the electricity bill of the premises had not been paid by the landlord.

If the connection of a premises is disconnected on account of non-payment of the electricity bill, then by any means, it cannot be said that

the authorities of the electricity department have gone wrong in law. If the petitioner is having any grievance against his landlord qua non-payment of bill or qua discontinuing the facilities to him, he has the remedy elsewhere. Learned counsel for the petitioner himself has pointed out that the landlord has now got filed a petition before the Rent Authority for eviction of the petitioner from the premises in question. Even, in these proceedings, the petitioner might be having statutory alternate remedies.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter.

Dismissed accordingly.
