Status report filed on behalf of the State is ordered to be taken on record.

Through the present petition, the primary challenge is to the lodging of a FIR against the petitioner's husband being FIR No.81 dated 25.07.2021, registered under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

Though several grounds have been taken in the petition on the basis of which quashing of the aforesaid FIR is sought, the same need not be referred to in the light of the stand of the State that after investigation, the State has prepared a report seeking therein cancellation of the impugned FIR and would be filing the same within one week before the competent

Court.

In the light of the above as also because learned State counsel has stated that the erring police officials are being proceeded against departmentally, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, he prays that on the strength of the same facts/alleged recovery of drugs/narcotics, if another FIR is lodged by the State against the petitioner's husband liberty be granted to challenge the same, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as not pressed with aforesaid liberty as prayed for.
