Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 23 dated 13.03.2020, under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 14.10.2020, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 14.10.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as
