[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 20.08.2021 in CWP No.15232 of 2021.

[3] Learned counsel contends that while adjourning the writ petition to 06.10.2021, the petitioner was permitted to run the stalls in question till the next date of hearing and the instant petition was filed on account of intentional and willful violation of the aforementioned order but pursuant to the issuance of notice of motion, the respondents have complied with order dated 20.08.2011 in CWP No.15232 of 2021, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition any further and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the needful having been done as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondents. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
