Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition was filed for issuance of directions to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from the private respondents arrayed in the petition.

As per the pleadings, the petitioners had performed marriage against the wishes of their parents, hence, there is a threat perception.

On 10th September 2021, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only at this stage.

Ms. Dimple Jain, AAG Haryana appearing on advance notice accepts the same and seeks time to have instructions.

Put up on 21.9.2021.

In the meantime, the police officials not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police should record the statements of the petitioners.

In case a request is made by the petitioners, they may be provided shelter in safe house till the next date.”

Learned State counsel has filed reply dated 18.9.2021 by way of an affidavit of Mr. Sudhir Taneja, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, H.Q. Nuh, through electronic medium. Copy of the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded by Deputy Superintendent of Police, H.Q. Nuh. It is stated therein that there is no threat perception.

In view of above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.
