1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. At the outset, learned Asstt. A.G., Punjab states that date i.e. 12.11.2020 in order dated 25.11.2020 may kindly be corrected so as to read as 24.11.2020. The same is not opposed to by learned counsel for the petitioners. Accordingly, Registry is directed to make necessary changes in order dated 25.11.2020. This order be read as a part of order dated 25.11.2020.

3. Learned State Counsel states that pursuant to order dated 25.11.2020, payment as per entitlement to the petitioner has been made in terms of order dated 24.11.2020 passed by respondent No.2.

4. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he does not press the contempt petition, at this stage and the same may be disposed of, as such, with liberty to the

petitioner to take out appropriate proceedings qua his grievance with regard to the remaining amount of payment, besides interest on the payment made, as well as claim for compassionate appointment.

5. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.
6. Accordingly, in the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is ***disposed of***, as not pressed at this stage with the liberty, as prayed for.
