Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners solemnized marriage on 07.09.2021 as per Sikh rites at Gurudwara Akalgarh Sahib, Village Karor Kalan, District Mohali. Now, they are facing threats from the family members of petitioner No.1-Parminder Kaur, who are against the alliance of the petitioners as petitioner No.2 belongs to different community and was previously married, but his first marriage has already been dissolved. He has further argued that despite the convincing efforts of the petitioners, private respondents refused to accept

their marriage. Petitioners have apprehension that private respondents will implicate them in a false case, therefore, a representation dated 07.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) has already been given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana, but no action has been taken upon the same, so they have approached this Court with a prayer to provide them protection. He prays that appropriate direction be issued.

After hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court finds that the petition is directed against the parents (natural guardian) and brother of petitioner No.1 and the bald averments contained in the petition are not substantiated with any convincing material. Further, the apprehension of the petitioners that private respondents would implicate them in a false criminal case, cannot be construed as a threat as they too are free to avail their remedy in law.

Apart from it, the representations submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.2 also lacks material particulars and does not reveal the manner and mode of alleged threat extended to the petitioners.

Resultantly, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
