Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in a case registered against him vide FIR No.163 dated 11.08.2020, under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, mainly on the ground that the parties have since resolved the matter and have compromised and that in fact a petition for quashing of FIR has already been filed.

The learned State counsel has submitted that pursuant to the interim directions, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter stands compromised and the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 14.10.2020 are made absolute subject to condition that petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands accepted accordingly.
