This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has filed the instant petition seeking issuance of directions to cancel/revoke license no. 60 of 2012 dated 11.06.2012 and renewed license no. 60 of 2012 dated 15.03.2021 alongwith license no. 133 of 2019 dated 17.12.2019 (granted in respect of license no. 60 of 2012).

An advance copy of the writ petition has already been served upon the State of Haryana.

Mr. Aman Bahri, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, submits that a notice dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-16) has already been sent by the petitioner to the Director General, DTCP carrying the same prayer as raised in the instant petition. He further submits that the matter would be considered in accordance with law, a survey would also be conducted and a final decision would thereafter be taken and for such purpose four months' time would be required.

In view of such stand taken on behalf of the State, we are not inclined to examine the prayer made in the instant writ petition on merits.

Writ petition is disposed of in the light of the statement made by Mr. Aman Bahri, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana that the notice dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P-16) would be dealt with in accordance with law and the final decision thereupon would be taken within a period of four months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
