The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No. 81 dated 11.07.2021 registered at Police Station City-I, Malerkotla, District Sangrur, under Sections 419,420,465,467,468,471 read with Section 120-B IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Harnek Singh of Police Station City-I, Malerkotla, District Sangrur, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 06.10.2021 as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench, the petitioner, who is stated to be the attesting witness of the agreement to sell in question, has joined in the investigation of this case and his custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the above-said submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the interim relief, as extended by the Co-ordinate Bench to the petitioner vide the said order dated 06.10.2021, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
