The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 180 dated 22.08.2020, under Sections 307, 452, 323, 324, 506, 427, 148, 149 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is a student of class 10, has been attributed a single injury with 'kirpan' on the back of the complainant.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 21.12.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Narender Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 21.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
