Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to release the gratuity amounting to the tune of Rs.10 lacs along with 18% interest and leave encashment to the tune of Rs.5 lacs along with 18% for the service rendered petitioner in the respondents bank which has not been released by the respondents till date.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the respondents to consider the representation dated 12.03.2020 (Annexure P-4) and legal notice dated 25.07.2021 (Annexure P-5) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
