VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

Present petition is under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner namely, Dipanshu Ahuja in case FIR No.46 dated 22.01.2019, registered under Sections 354, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 IPC, at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

On 28.06.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner would contend that mediation process between the parties remained unsuccessful. It is further submitted that the car received in dowry has already been returned to the complainant, as would be evident from the FIR itself. It is submitted that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation and cooperate.

Adjourned to 07.10.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of one week and on his doing so, in the event of arrest the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

The order dated 11.10.2021 further indicates that on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, it was submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar further states that his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of aforesaid submissions, order dated 28.06.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
