This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to conduct fair investigation in case FIR No.80 dated 20.08.2021 under Sections 148, 336 and 506 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed in case the instant petition is treated as representation on behalf of the petitioner and if the same is ordered to be disposed of by respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, Police District Batala, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 5 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, Police District Batala, to treat the instant petition as representation and to look into and decide the same in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
