The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the full and final retiral benefits such as gratuity, leave encashment, arrears of salary etc along with interest from the date of retirement i.e. 30.04.2018 till its realization as raised in legal notice dated 28.06.2021 (Annexure P-2) payable to the petitioner on his retirement from the services in terms of orders dated 20.09.2017 and 11.06.2020 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) passed by this Hon'ble court in case of similarly situated employees.

Mr. Shireesh Gupta, Senior DAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 28.06.2021 (Annexure P-2) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.
