This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.105 dated 04.06.2021 under Sections 452, 458, 324, 323, 427, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 458 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot. The petitioners apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 15.09.2021, whereby while issuing notice of motion, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel contends that the alleged injuries suffered by the injured were simple in nature and the co-accused of the petitioners has already been extended the concession of interim pre arrest bail vide order dated 04.08.2021 passed in CRM-M-30871-2021.

Notice of motion for 24.11.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions

*as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
To be heard along with CRM-M-30871-2021.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioners submitted themselves before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioners cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Beant Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation. He further states that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2021 is made absolute.
