Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 01.09.2020 suspending the petitioner from the post of Pharmacist. A reading of the order of suspension shows that the petitioner was suspended on the ground that a disciplinary proceeding is likely to be initiated against him for illegally recording the proceedings of an inquiry committee constituted vide notification dated 13.08.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time prays that he has already filed an appeal against the order of suspension which should be directed to be decided by the respondents. Sh. Sajjan Singh, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-University submits that the petitioner has filed the appeal before the Chancellor whereas it is maintainable before the Executive Council.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the competent authority to take a final decision in the appeal as per the rules/regulations. Even if it is found that the appeal has not been properly addressed to the competent authority, the competent authority is directed to take note of the appeal Annexure P12 and decide the same within a period of two months.
