The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 27.07.2021 registered under Sections 417, 379B, 120 and 506 IPC at Police Station Thulliwal, District Barnala.

On 14.09.2021 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners inter-alia contends that the petitioners, who are ladies, have been falsely implicated in this case; in the FIR in question, there is no allegation against the petitioners and that the dispute which was subject matter of the FIR in question has been compromised with the complainant.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jagmohan Singh Ghumman, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for time to argue the matter.

Adjourned to 13.12.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioners' joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of their arrest in FIR No.0051, dated 27.07.2021, registered under Sections 417, 379-B, 120, 506 IPC at Police Station Thulliwal, District Barnala, they shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioners have joined investigation; have cooperated with the investigating agency; the matter has been compromised and that the petitioners' custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above and the statement made by learned State counsel that the petitioners' custodial interrogation is not required, the order of this Court dated 14.09.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
