The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.30 dated 17.02.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 324, 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was arraigned as an accused on the statement of the co-accused recorded 06 months after the occurrence.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 15.10.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Om Parkash, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 15.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
