The petitioner has filed this petition allegedly in public interest vehemently stating that the action of the respondents is in contravention of the statutory provisions of Section 20(3) of the Haryana Police Act, 2007. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner relied upon and quoted Section 20(3) of the Haryana Police Act, 2007 on page Nos. 13 and 14 of the petition. When Haryana Police Act, 2007 is examined, it is observed that there is no section 20(3) in the statute book.
