The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.0016, dated 13th March, 2019, registered under Section 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. In compliance of the previous order dated 12th March, 2020, the Petitioner had tendered the affidavit (Annexure P-8) of his son along with other documents including screen-shots from the CCTV footage to show that the truck in question was in Malerkotla in the afternoon of 12th March, 2019 as also the private registered cars of ASI Pyara Singh and HC Lakhvir Singh who were both part of the raiding party.

3. In this view of the matter and considering that the Petitioner was released on an interim bail after having remained in detention for more

than 1 year apart from the fact that there is no record of his involvement under the NDPS Act, such interim bail granted to him earlier on 12th March, 2020 is hereby confirmed during pendency of the trial.
