Petitioners-Bhupinder Pal Singh Premi and Inderjit Kaur stated to be aged 50 years and 45 years respectively, have jointly filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer for directing the official respondents especially respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 12.07.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, Asst. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the Labour Inspector, Malerkotla, has pointed out that there are many essential pre-requirements before the case of the petitioner, can be considered by the Competent Authority.

In view of the matter, the present writ petition is disposed of with the following directions:-

1. The petitioner may approach the Labour Inspector, Malerkotla within **three weeks** from the date of receipt of the certified copy.

2. The Labour Inspector, Malerkotla may inform about all the required documents to the counsel or the petitioner.

3. If the petitioner, thereafter makes a representation attaching all the required documents, the Competent Authority may consider and decide the same within a period of **three months** from the date of receipt of said representation.
