HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed by the petitioner apprehending threat to her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a dispute of *rasta* between the house of the petitioner and her neighbours and the petitioner is being threatened by the neighbours and the property of the petitioner has also been demolished, which grievance has been raised before the authorities concerned.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the said grievance, which is also being raised in the present petition, has already been raised by the petitioner before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot vide representation dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to

respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P-6) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P-6), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 08.06.2021 (Annexure P-6) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated if all the parties to the dispute are heard before passing the order.
