The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.69 dated 19.07.2021, registered for offences under Sections 326, 325, 323, 324, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 326 and 325 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 were added later on) and Sections 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station, Verowal, District Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1).

Having argued the petition for some time and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with the submissions made, counsel for the petitioner submits that the he does not want to press the instant petition and submits that the petitioner will surrender before the Trial Court and join the proceedings.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and files a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide the same within a period of one week from the date of its filing.

Petition is disposed of.
